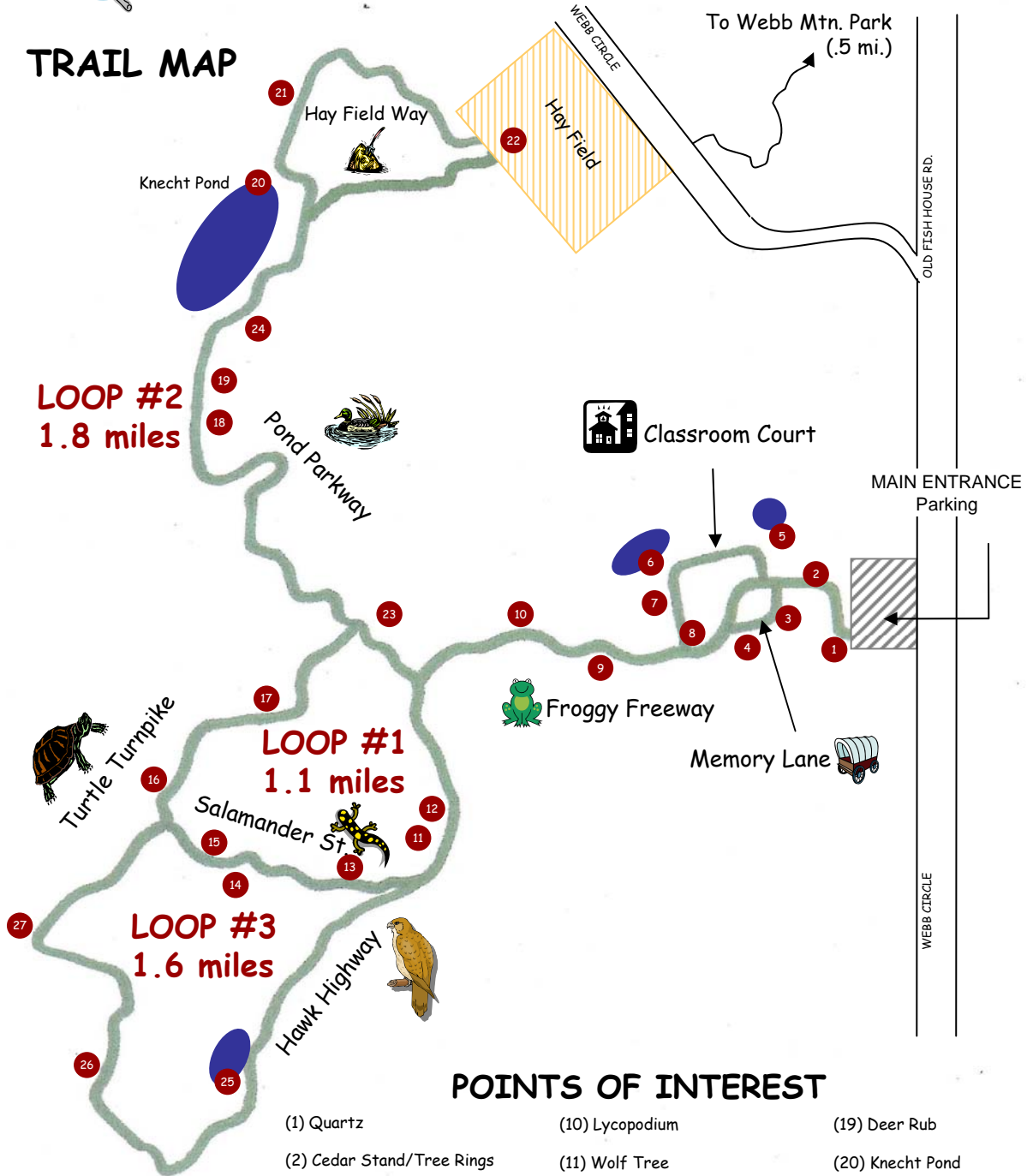

TRAIL MAP & LOOPS

LOOP #1 - 1.1 miles

From parking lot take Froggy Freeway
Left onto Hawk Highway
Right onto Salamander St.
Right onto Turtle Turnpike
Follow back to Froggy Freeway

LOOP #2 - 1.8 miles

From parking lot take Froggy Freeway
Right onto Turtle Turnpike
At intersection, right onto Pond Parkway
Merge onto Hay Field Way (loop to Hay Field)
Return via Pond Parkway
At intersection, left onto Turtle Turnpike
Left onto Froggy Freeway

LOOP #3 - 1.6 miles

From parking lot take Froggy Freeway
Left onto Hawk Highway
Follow down and around until Hawk Highway
merges with Turtle Turnpike
Follow Turtle Turnpike back to Froggy Freeway
